Renzo Piano Pavilion

Pavilion Lobby

Designed by Italian architect Renzo Piano in 2013, the Piano Pavilion is the ideal venue for corporate or social events. The Pavilion Lobby's silvery concrete and floor-to-ceiling glass walls create the perfect backdrop for a seated dinner or cocktail reception. Kahn West Lobby

Designed by American architect Louis I. Kahn in the 1970s, the Kahn Building is considered one of the greatest architectural achievements of the twentieth century. Under the iconic vaulted ceiling of the West Lobby, the landmark building provides a striking space for cocktail receptions, private dinners, and more. To make your event even more special, choose to have the art galleries open during the event or incorporate the stunning West Portico.



Gallery Access

The Kimbell's collection is comprised of antiquities, European art, Asian art, art of the Ancient Americas, and African and Oceanic art. The museum also hosts multiple highly acclaimed international special exhibitions each year.

Galleries may be open for private events for an additional \$500 per gallery, per hour, plus staffing fees. In addition to the gallery fee, ticketing fees for special exhibitions apply. The Kimbell's permanent collection has no ticketing fees.
